### SCHEDULE REMINDERS FOR HOLIDAY CLOSURES

#### **Christmas Holiday Closure - Friday, December 24th and Monday, December 27th**

If you receive frozen meals on Fridays or Mondays, all of your meals will be delivered earlier in the week. If you don't usually receive frozen meals but will need them for the closure, call us to discuss your needs by Friday, December 17th.

#### **New Year's Day Closure - Friday, December 31st**

If you are in need of frozen meals for the closure, please call us to discuss your needs by Monday, December 28th. We will not be moving Friday meals earlier in the week unless you call to ask.

### **From the Boulder County DA**

Scammers are sending fake emails that appear to be from the US CDC or other experts claiming to have new info about Covid-19.

Only visit reliable resources for the most up-to-date information on Covid-19, like Boulder County Public Health, Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment and the CDC.

Don't click on links in unsolicited emails or from sources you don't know. These links can lead you to a fake website or can download malicious software (malware) or a virus onto your computer. Make sure the anti-malware and anti-virus software on your computer is up to date.
