COVID-19 Vaccination and Boosters for Homebound Clients

Longmont Meals on Wheels is collecting information for homebound clients in need of COVID-19 vaccination or boosters. If your doctor feels you are immunocompromised and you truly are homebound, we can help you receive an in-home vaccine or booster vaccine. Please consult your doctor first.

Call us for assistance, and be prepared with the following information: first & last name, phone number (preferably the individual rather than a primary caregiver), home address and preferred time of day to be contacted.

When a vaccination date and time is available, a vaccine clinic representative will reach out to you with more information.

The Parkview Café Is Open

The Park View Café at the Longmont Senior Center is welcoming diners Monday through Friday with limited seating, serving meals 11:30 to 12:00. Meals can be eaten in the dining room or packed to go. Seating in the dining room will be limited and socially distanced, so we anticipate most diners will choose to take their meal to go. Prices are on our sliding scale, according to your income, from \$2.00 to \$5.50, with visitors under 55 years old paying \$6.00. Milk, juice or coffee will be included. Payment will be cash only unless you would like to purchase a multi-meal punch card. The dining room menu will follow the home delivery menu. Coffee service without a meal will cost 75¢.
